Functions	<p>Building Queensland is the Queensland Government’s independent infrastructure advisor—providing advice to departments, government owned corporations and selected statutory authorities.</p> <p>Our role is to develop a pipeline of proposals considered to be priorities for the state, and to prepare robust business cases to inform investment decisions.</p>				
Achievements	<p>In 2017–18 Building Queensland completed 11 detailed business cases which helped inform the government’s infrastructure decision-making.</p> <p>Building Queensland also produced two updates of the Infrastructure Pipeline Report. Combined, 37 priority proposals were identified with 11 receiving funding commitments from the state.</p> <p>Building Queensland helped bring forward a new focus on transparency in infrastructure planning having released four business cases in addition to our statutory requirement to publish cost benefit analysis summaries.</p>
